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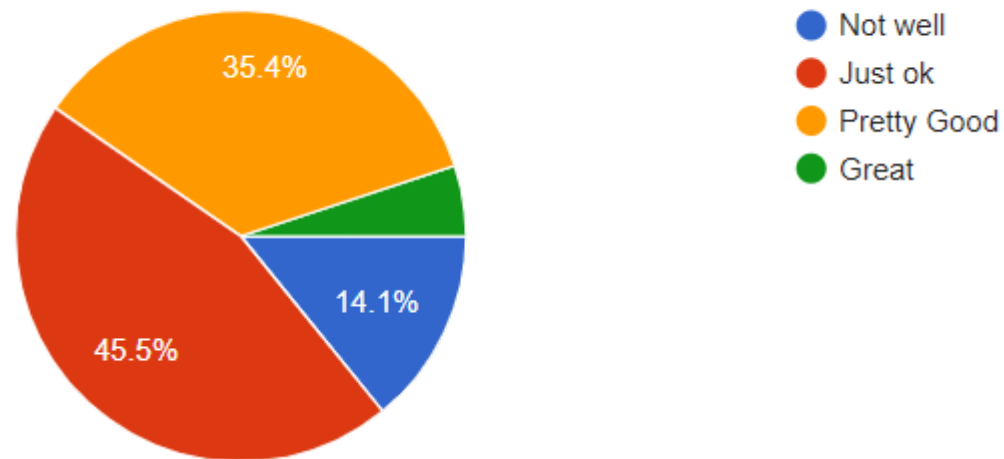

# Key Points

1. Communication and Organization
  - a. Sending out assignments on Wednesdays via Blackboard announcements, including readings and VoiceThread lectures.
  - b. Organizing folders by week on Blackboard
2. Meet once a week on Mondays
3. Structure of Monday meetings
  - a. Roadmap of the class meeting
  - b. Brief review of VoiceThread lecture
  - c. Breakout Rooms Discussion
    - i. Students pre-assigned for consistency; preregistration to meeting is required
    - ii. Polls to vote on discussion questions
4. Using Zoom Features
  - a. Use of polls
    - i. During class discussion: bilingualism example
    - ii. To continuously improve course: eliciting feedback from students on course preferences (e.g., amount of time in Breakout Rooms, whether to lump all q's together or break out individually)
    - iii. To select weekly Breakout Room questions
  - b. Chat – haven't figured out how to effectively use this in a large class
  - c. Attendance – Zoom reports

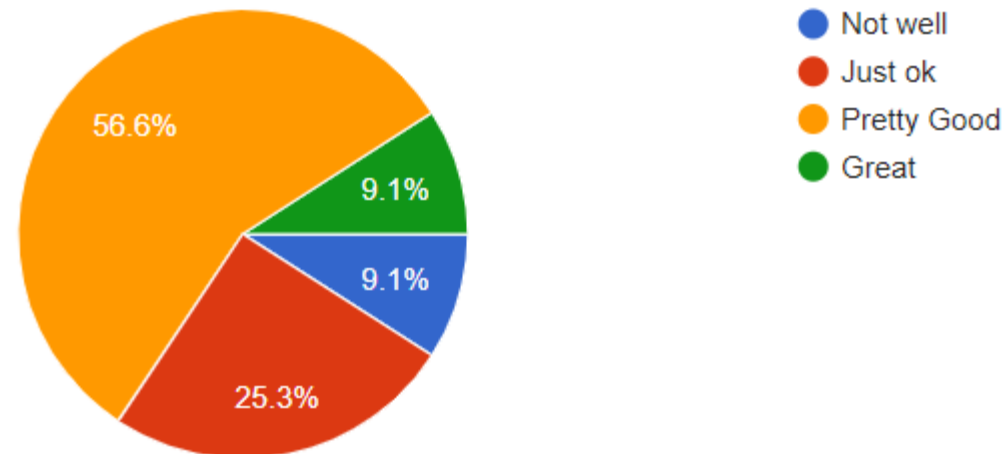
# Student Feedback Survey (n=99)

- How are you doing emotionally/psychologically at this point in the semester?



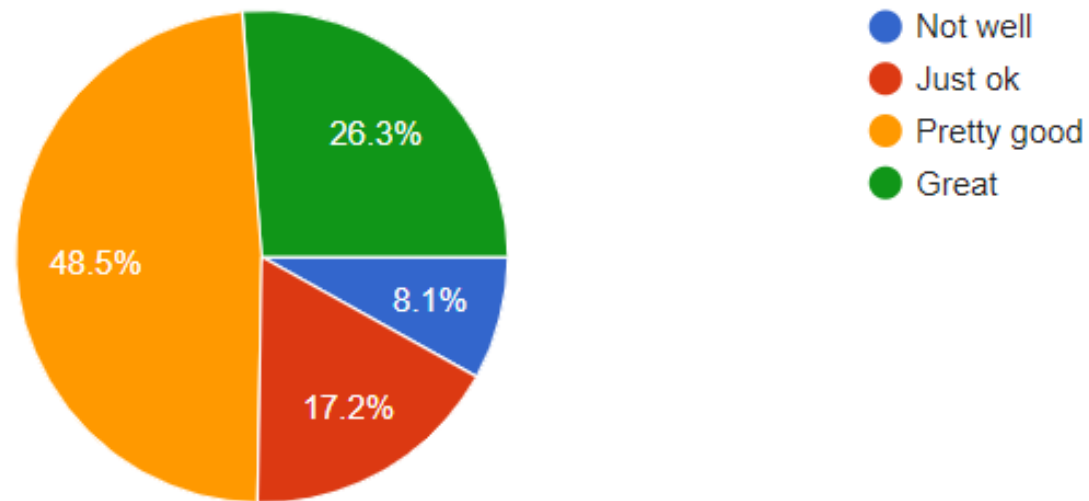
# Student Feedback Survey (n=99)

- How do you feel you are doing academically in this course so far?



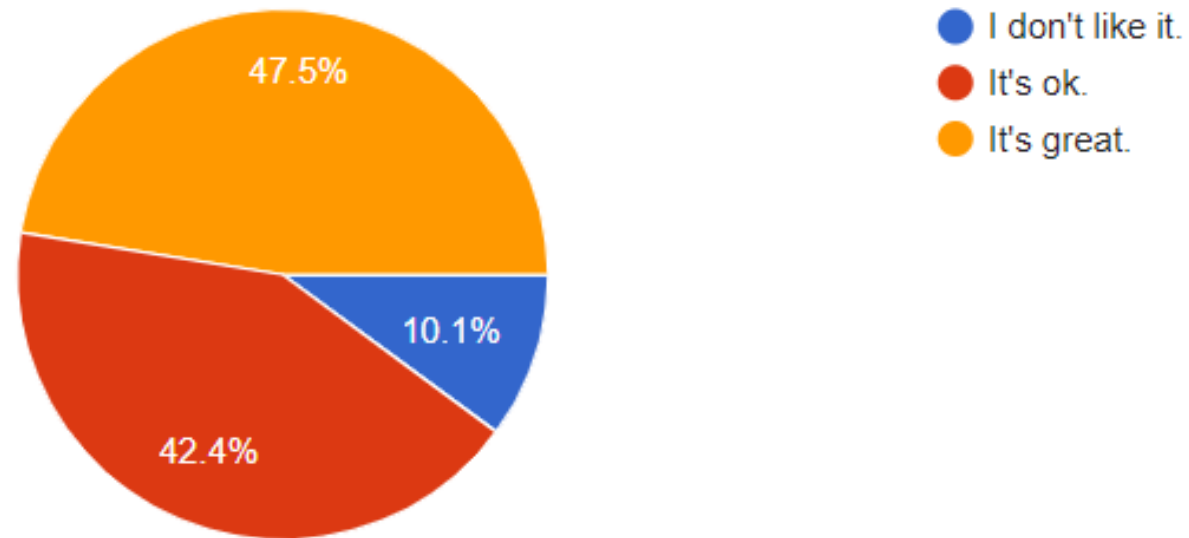
# Student Feedback Survey (n=99)

  - Clear communication and organization
  - Workload not overly heavy

# Student feedback survey (n=99)

- What can I do as an instructor to improve this course?
  - Go over assignment due dates at the end of each class
  - Give some more time for large-group discussion outside the breakout groups
  - Mix up the breakout groups at times
  - Show more videos
  - Clarify how attendance is captured
  - Continuing to make study sheets for exams
  - Give assignments on Mondays instead of Wednesdays
  - Review some of the material before exams
  - More lecture time
